STEP 1

Apply for your provisional licence from DVLA (Driver and Vehicle Licencing Agency).

To do this, you must submit completed D2 and D4 forms to DVLA.

The D2 form is completed by yourself and the D4 form is completed by the doctor who conducts your medical examination. There will be a fee payable for this service and will vary depending on the doctor or surgery.
